1	A JOINT RESOLUTION expressing support for phasing out the
2	sale of new electric vehicles in Wyoming by 2035.

4	WHEREAS, oil and gas production has long been one of Wyoming's
5	proud and valued industries; and
б	
7	WHEREAS, the oil and gas industry in Wyoming has created
8	countless jobs and has contributed revenues to the state of
9	Wyoming throughout the state's history; and
10	
11	WHEREAS, since its invention, the gas-powered vehicle has
12	enabled the state's industries and businesses to engage in
13	commerce and transport goods and resources more efficiently
14	throughout the country; and

1 2 WHEREAS, Wyoming's vast stretches of highway, coupled with a lack of electric vehicle charging infrastructure, make the 3 4 widespread use of electric vehicles impracticable for the 5 state; and б 7 WHEREAS, the batteries used in electric vehicles contain critical minerals whose domestic supply is limited and at 8 9 risk for disruption; and 10 11 WHEREAS, the critical minerals used in electric batteries are not easily recyclable or disposable, meaning that municipal 12 13 landfills in Wyoming and elsewhere will be required to develop practices to dispose of these minerals in a safe and 14 15 responsible manner; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the expansion of electric vehicle charging stations in Wyoming and throughout the country necessary to support 18 more electric vehicles will require massive amounts of new 19 20 power generation in order to sustain the misadventure of 21 electric vehicles; and

1 WHEREAS, the United States has consistently invested in the 2 oil and gas industry to sustain gas-powered vehicles, and that investment has resulted in the continued employment of 3 4 thousands of people in the oil and gas industry in Wyoming 5 and throughout the country; and б 7 WHEREAS, fossil fuels, including oil and petroleum products, will continue to be vital for transporting goods and people 8 9 across Wyoming and the United States for years to come; and 10 11 WHEREAS, the proliferation of electric vehicles at the 12 expense of gas-powered vehicles will have deleterious impacts 13 on Wyoming's communities and will be detrimental to Wyoming's 14 economy and the ability for the country to efficiently engage 15 in commerce; and 16 17 WHEREAS, phasing out the sale of new electric vehicles in Wyoming by 2035 will ensure the stability of Wyoming's oil 18 19 and gas industry and will help preserve the country's critical

20 minerals for vital purposes.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE 23 LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

2 Section 1. That the legislature encourages and expresses as a goal that the sale of new electric vehicles in 3 4 the state of Wyoming be phased out by 2035. 5 б Section 2. That the legislature encourages Wyoming's 7 industries and citizens to limit the sale and purchase of new electric vehicles in Wyoming with a goal of phasing out the 8 9 sale of new electric vehicles in Wyoming by 2035. 10 Section 3. That the Secretary of State of Wyoming 11 12 transmit copies of this resolution to the President of the 13 United States, each member of Wyoming's congressional delegation, the President of the United States Senate, the 14 Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the 15 16 governor of Wyoming and the governor of California. 17 18 (END)
